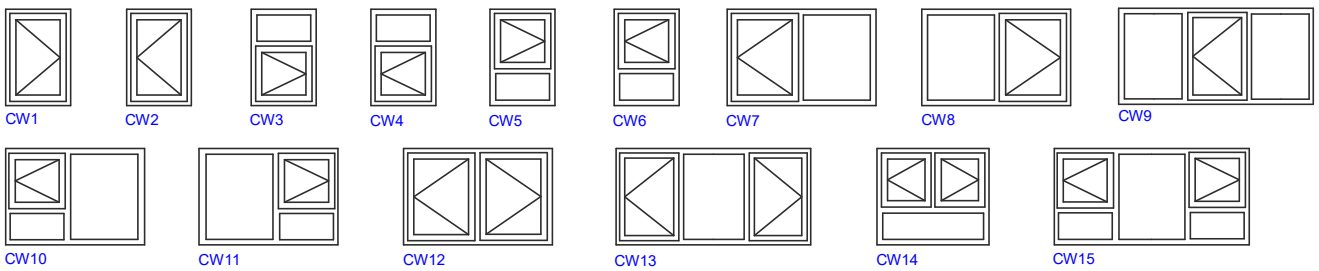

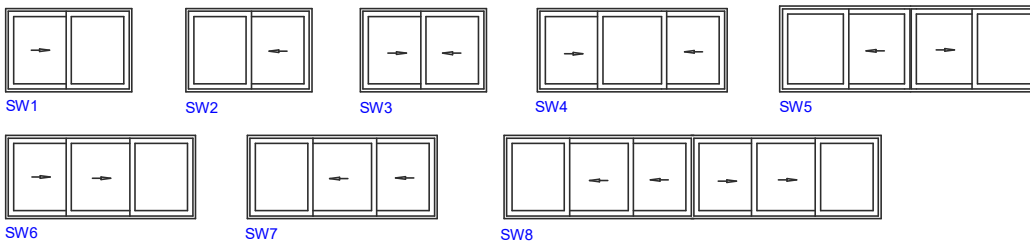

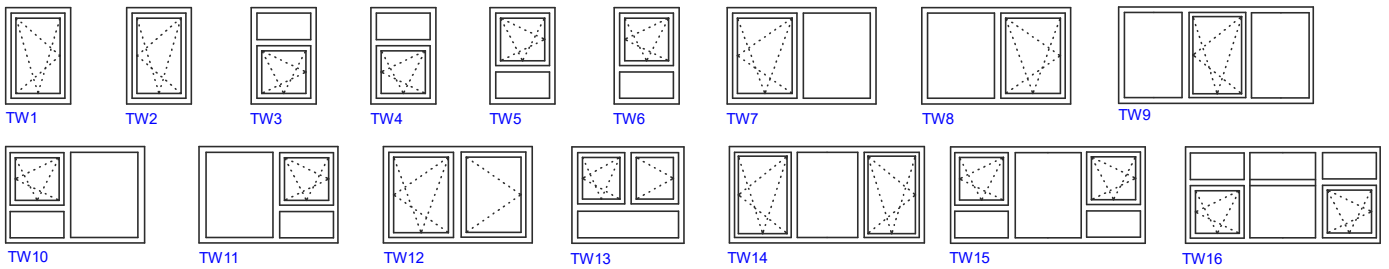

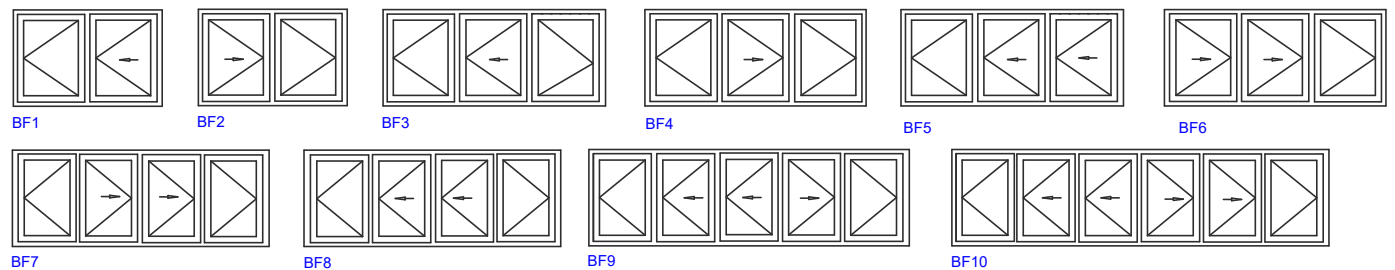

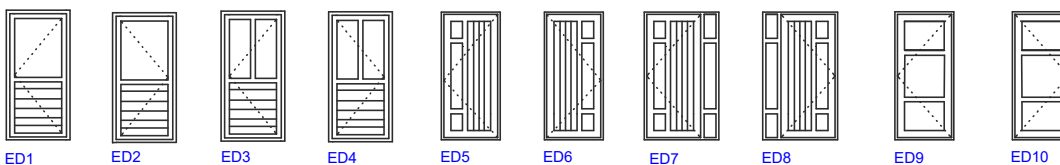

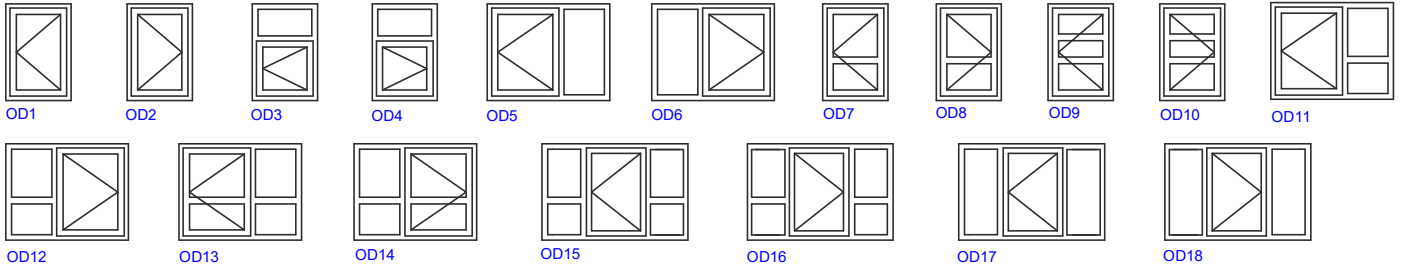

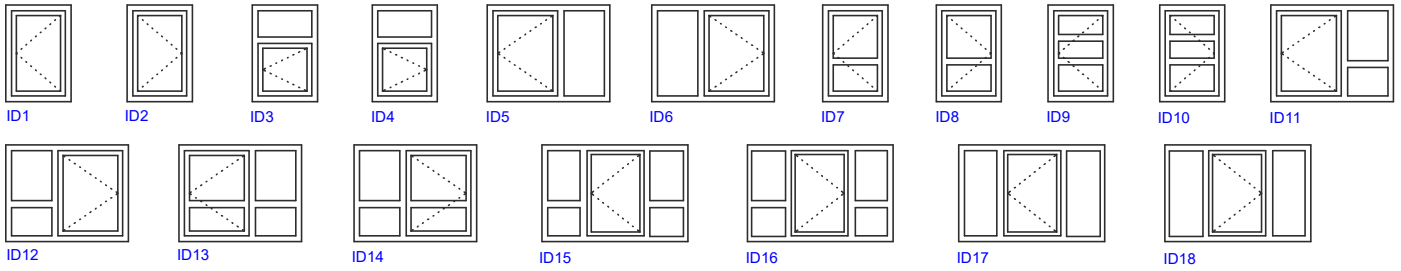

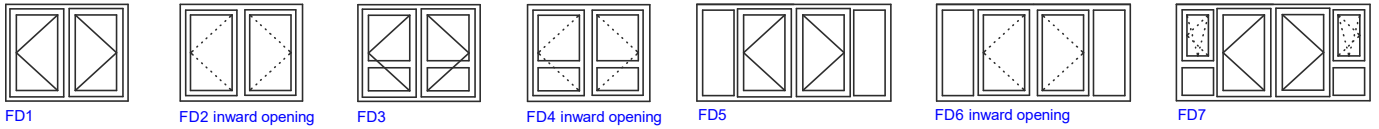
Hinged Doors Outward Opening



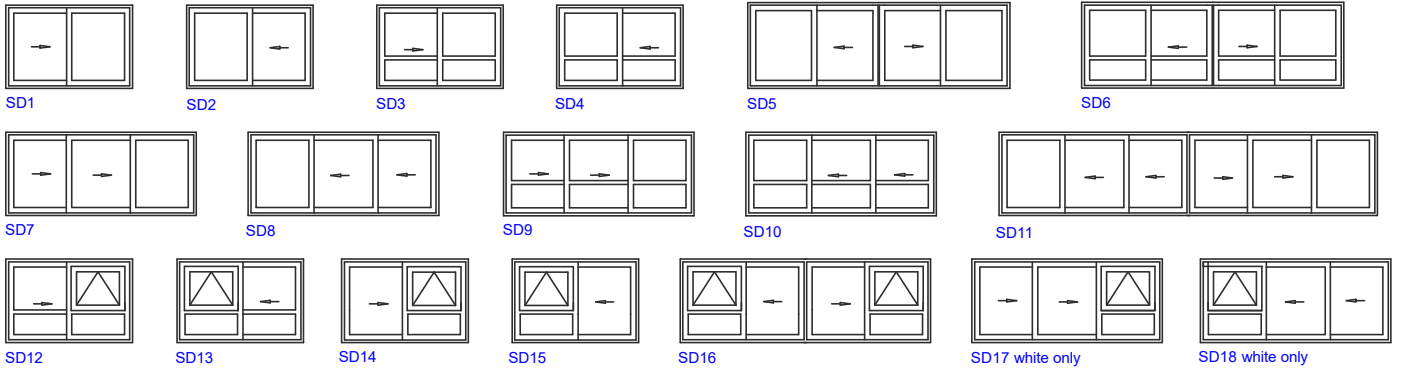

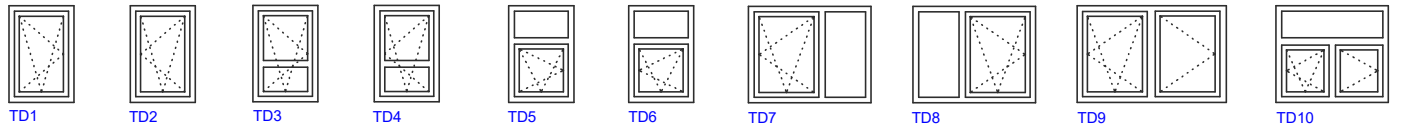

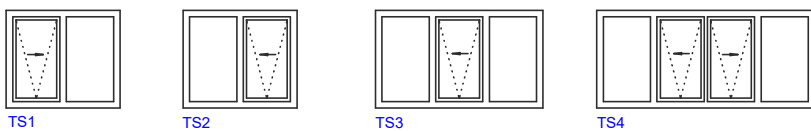
